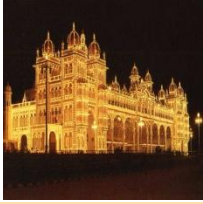


Mysore Palace

Distance : 4 KM



With its Majestic Architecture and Royal Aura, the Mysore palace is the Crown Jewel of Mysore, the City of Palaces. Intricately arved rosewood doors and ceilings some with inlaid Ivory Work, Marble Figurines, Collections of Caskets, Paintings of the members of the Royal Family and other objects of personal use exhibit such Opulence, though age as worn them out a bit with slight discolouration.

GRS Fantasy Park

Distance : 5 KM

New Attraction - Introduced for the first time in India, this sledging slope Gives a feel of sliding down an ice covered hill from a height of 35 feet, with 4 lanes having a length of 200 feet. Fantasy Park is a high-tech, action packed entertainer with amazing things to do for all ages.

St Philominas Church

Distance : 6 KM



A beautiful Cathedral, reminiscent of medieval architectural style, is one of the largest churches in the country. Built in the Gothic style, the Church is an imposing structure with stained glass windows and lofty towers.

Hebbal Industrial Area

Race Course

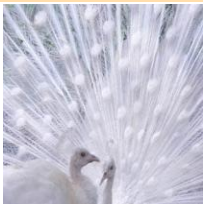
Distance : 6 KM

Mysore Zoo

Distance : 6 KM



Mysore Zoo or Shri Chamarajendra Zoological Gardens is one of the oldest zoo in India. It is home to a wide range of Wild species. The Zoo not only has an excellent collection of animals, it has a beautiful bandstand and had a picturesque setting with the Chamundi hills as its backdrop and an Artificial Lake on its premises.

Mysore Bus Stand

Distance : 5 KM

Bird Sanctuary

Distance : 14 KM



It is home to some of the most Exotic Birds. It is a group of small Islands in the Cauvery River. Ranganthittu was formed as a result of a small Dam across the River Cauvery in the 1600s. The sanctuary is home to a wide species of birds including Cormorants, Darters, White Ibis, Spoon Billed Storks, Open Billed Storks, Painted Storks, White Necked Storks, Egrets, Herons, Terns, Swallows, Kingfisher

Metagalli Industrial Area

Distance : 6 KM



Industries in Mysore district are mainly concentrated around the cities of Mysore and Nanjangud. Karnataka Industrial Areas Development Board (KIADB) has established Metagalli Industrial Area in Mysore district to encourage Industrial Development of the district.

Karanji Lake

Distance : 6 km



Karanji Kere is a small Lake inside the city. This is a favorite spot of romantic couples. You can go for a small trip of Boating. The Lake is surrounded by green trees and you can also see various variety of birds like Pelicans and Painted Storks on the Island in Karanji Kere.

Tippu Summer Palace

Distance : 15 KM



Its unique structure was completely built of wood so commonly known as Wooden Palace. The Fort stands as a witness to the struggle of the Mysore Emperor against the British domination. On either side of the Palace are beautiful gardens, which lead to its main entrance. There are beautiful Floral Motifs Embellishing the Walls as well as the Ceilings of the Tipu Sultan Palace in Bengaluru.

Brindavan Garden

Distance : 15 KM



Brindavan Gardens and Musical Fountain at the Krishna Raja Sagar Dam. Nice garden full of fountains, in the neighborhood of Mysore. At 7PM the "Musical Fountain" light and music show begins.

Jaganmohan Art Gallery

Distance : 3 KM



A former palace that has been converted into a wonderful Art Gallery featuring famous works by various Indian artists. The art gallery contains one of the largest collection of artifacts in South India. The famous \Gold Leaf\ paintings of Mysore, Raja Ravi Varma and Svetoslav Roerich.
